Golden Jubilee of Graduation of the 1st batch celebrated in college with a one day function. Former faculty members of 1962, family members of the first batch, executive members of the Alumni and heads of departments participated. The batch contributed Rs 3,23,000 to GEcT SAFE. This includes Rs 1,10,000 from the 1st couple among the GECT graduates, Er V N Sreedharan Nair and Er Sarojini Appissi.

Silver Jubilee of Graduation of the 1981 86 batch celebrated on 14th Aug 2011 with a one day function in college. The batch contributed Rs 8,05,000 to the GEcT SAFE. This is the biggest contribution so far from a batch.

The ME and PE branch of 1980-85 batch donated Rs 1,75,000 and the EE branch donated rs 75,000 to SAFE.

The chennai chapter donated Rs 75,000 to SAFE.

The contributions to SAFE has reached Rs 22,42,772. Rs 19,50,000 out of this is maintained as FD at SBT cherur. A 10 member committee to select the students has been constituted. The first lot of help will be distributed in Feb 2012 to 15 students.

The graduation day of the 2011 batch celebrated in college in June 2011. The address book of this batch was prepared by Alumni Association.

Reunion of the 1981 batch Electrical engineering was conducted in college on 30-07-2011. They contributed Rs 50,000 to SAFE. Reunion of the 1991 batch was conducted on 14-08-2011.

The college magazines are being digitized. The first lot containing 10 magazines were given as memento to the 1962 batch on their golden jubilee of Graduation.

TRACE, UAE contributed Rs 1,50,000 for beautification of the college campus. Using this a mural painting of Er Visweswaraya was painted on the Eastern Amphi wall by a group of students. The protection bank around the 'Mavinchodu' and the tree planted by the 62 batch near the eastern amphi theater, to commemorate their golden jubilee were sponsored by TRACE. Waterproofing of the terrace of the main building and landscaping of the front of the main building also were sponsored by TRACE. The I S O preparation work is nearing completion. Under the guidance of Er C G Subramanian of 83 batch ME, 2 internal audits were conducted. The external audit is planned in April 2012.

The accreditation by NBA was conducted in college in the Civil, Mechanical, Electrical and Chemical engg departments in Nov 2011. This was well supported by the Alumni Association.

The Caution deposit of the 2009 batch was released from office. 50 % of the amount collected from the 2008 and 2009 batches were distributed to each department to help the accreditation work. The Association also fixed Quality policy boards in different parts of the Main building and Department buildings.

The college has become an institutional member of IE(I) with the help of Alumni association and Parent Teacher Association.

Accreditation by IE(I) was also conducted in Dec 2011 to confirm the institutional membership. A team of Faulty from PSG college, Coimbatore visited the campus.

B2C programs were conducted in Civil, Mechanical, Chemical and Electrical engineering Departments. Alumni Association also helped to promote the Placement activities of the college.

The Alumni association is preparing the student verification request by companies with help from the college office and departments to confirm the qualification of students. 96 verification reports were sent this year. Out of the total amount received so far, 50 % of the fee is distributed to each department.

The Trichur Chapter of Alumni who are members of TMA conducted a caliber up gradation program from in Feb 2011 for 30 Final year students. The Placement cell helped to organise the program.

The Alumni association supported to conduct the C P Ayyappan memorial Hockey tournament in February 2011.

GECT secured 3 First, Second and Third ranks in the 2009 B Tech results of Calicut University and the First 3 ranks in B Arch 2010. Including them, 22 students of GECT who are rank holders of Calicut University B Tech 2009 and B Arch 2010 were felicitated during the Graduation day of 2011.
