

Hostel Admission norms

Priority for the available vacancies in the Engineering college hostel

Priority 1: - 20% of the vacant seats for students belonging to categories SC/ST/BPL/PH/Government of India

Priority for the 20% reserved seats

- 1) All Govt. of India nominees
- 2) All Physically handicapped students
- 3) SC/ST B.Tech students
- 4) BPL students of B.Tech First year

Priority 2: -Proportion of seats for other students based on merit and distance

- 1) First year UG students – 30% (*)
- 2) Final year UG students – 30% (**)
- 3) Third year UG students – 20% (**)
- 4) Second year UG students – 10% (**)
- 5) First year PG students – 5% (*)
- 6) Second /Final year PG students– 5% (**)

Criteria to be considered during hostel admission

- 1) Minimum distance of student's residence from the College should be 15km
- 2) If the number of applicants under SC/ST and BPL categories are greater than the available reserved seats, admission will be provided based on merit and distance
- 3) Vacant seats if any after admission of UG students will be allotted to third year UG students
- 4) PG students not receiving any kind of scholarships/grants will be given first priority
- 5) Admission to PG (non GATE) First year students will be based on B.Tech marks and Distance

*** For first year UG, PG & third semester lateral entry students (20% weightage for merit and 80% weightage for distance)**

$$\text{Net Point} = \frac{(\text{Last rank} - R) * 20}{\text{Last rank}} + \frac{D * 80}{M}$$

Where R - Entrance rank of the student

D - Distance of the student's residence from the college (Km)

M - Maximum distance from the college to the residence of a student (Km)

**** For other UG & PG students (50% weightage for merit and 50% weightage for distance)**

$$\text{Net Point} = \text{CGPA} * 5 + \frac{D * 50}{M}$$

Where CGPA - CGPA of previous semesters

D - Distance of student's residence from the college (Km)

M - Maximum distance from the college to the residence of a student (Km)

-In case a tie occurs, the priority is for i) Distance ii) CGPA of previous semesters iii) Lesser number of subjects failed

Note: Discrepancies or complaints if any received during Hostel admission will be considered for further amendments towards successive admissions.
