General Rules and Regulations, Government Engineering College Thrissur

- Students must carry their Identity Cards with them in the college and produce it as and when required by the faculty, supporting staff or any employee of the college.
- Every student shall attend classes regularly
- Ragging of any sort is strictly prohibited. Students found guilty of this offence will be referred to police as the same has been declared as a criminal offence by the Government.
- Students are not permitted to use mobile phones in the library, class rooms and examination hall.
- Students shall take proper care of the college furniture and fixtures. They must not cause any damage to the college property.
- Students are not permitted to exhibit any type of festoons, banners, flags, boards etc. inside the campus, hostels, buildings, gates or on the compound walls.
- Students shall refrain from writing, painting and drawing on the wall or furniture of the college.
- Students cannot form any society/club in the college without the prior permission of the Principal, nor shall any person can be invited to address a meeting in the college without the formal consent of the Principal.
- No function shall be arranged by the students in the hostel or college campus without prior permission from the Principal.
- Students coming by two wheelers are instructed to wear helmet. They should possess a valid driving license. All student vehicles must be parked in the dedicated space reserved for them.
- Students are not allowed to take any of their motor vehicles into/inside the campus.
- Abstain from the possession or consumption of narcotic drugs, alcohol and other intoxicating substances in the campus and hostels.
- Engaging in gherao, keeping under captivity or illegally confining any official of the Institute is prohibited.

- Disruption of, or improper interference with the academic, administrative, sporting, social
 or other activities of the institute, whether on institute premises or elsewhere will be
 treated as acts of indiscipline.
- Using abusive language and creating nuisance in the college premises will be considered as act of indiscipline.
- Disturbing the peace and independent rights of fellow students and faculty/staff members will be considered as act of indiscipline.
- No student shall collect money either by request or by coercion from others within the campus.
- Any case of criminal activity or violation of law and order in the campus will be reported to the police.
- Students charged with criminal offence or under suspension shall not enter the campus without the permission of the Principal.
- The Institute has a "Grievance Cell" where the students can raise their grievances.
- Students are advised not to litter and instead use dust/garbage bins to maintain cleanliness in and around the college premises, hostels and college ground.
- Students must conserve electricity and water. They must switch off lights & fans when they leave their class rooms and laboratories.
- Every student should follow the instructions given by the faculty of the Physical Education Department during sports activities on the ground.
