

GUIDELINES ON THE VOTING PROCEDURE BEING FOLLOWED FOR THE POLL ON 10.01.2022

- Students should bring original photo bearing identity card issued by the institution for voting.
- Student voters should wear masks properly before entering the polling station.
- Students should lower their masks for identification purpose if demanded by the polling officer in charge of identification.
- Polling agents should display their identity card.
- No use of mobile phones or other digital gadgets to record any activity in the polling station will be allowed.
- Voters will be checked through thermal scanner for their body temperature, and if it falls above 102.2 degrees Fahrenheit (39 degrees Centigrade) they will be disallowed from voting within the polling time from 10 hrs to 13 hrs. They can vote after that time at a polling booth specially set up for the purpose. (Academic Block – Room No. 101)
- Students have to strictly follow social distancing norms when they queue up for voting outside the booth, marking for which are put on the floor.
- Only a maximum of 3 students will be allowed at a time inside the polling booth.
- Voters currently infected with COVID and under quarantine (norms for their travel are decided by the Health department) can vote at a designate specific polling booth. They can arrive at the booth from 1 PM onwards and have to come dressed in proper PPE Kit and have to leave the campus immediately after voting. They also have to produce a medical certificate from a registered medical practitioner indicating that status. (Room no. 109 of Main Building)s
- Voters are advised to strictly follow the instructions in their polling booth for ensuring smooth polling.
- No campaigning of any sort should be resorted on the polling day.
- Observers are posted in all polling booths and ensure that their instructions are also followed.
