Request submitted by the student shall be verified by the institution before submitting to the university for final verification through portal. Students have to pay Rs.315/- as fee for certificate through portal.

ORDER

The 24th meeting of the Syndicate held on 22.07.2021 had approved the recommendations of the Syndicate Standing Committee on Examinations and resolved to conduct additional examinations to students infected with Covid-19/suffering from Covid related infections/quarantine and were unable to report for offline examinations and decided to treat the additional examination as their first/regular chance subject to their eligibility for the same. Later SSC decided not to conduct a separate additional examination. Instead, students may be allowed to register for the forthcoming exam when conducted as per the regulations and their chance in the said examination can be treated as first chance.

The 20th Meeting of the Syndicate Standing Committee on Examinations, held on 16.01.2022, considered the matter and resolved to implement the following measures to address the issue of Covid-19 affected students who were not able to attend the examinations due to the pandemic.

- (i) To provide provision in portal to enter the details such as student name, register number, name of exam in which (s)he was absent due to Covid related issue and details of courses in which (s)he was absent and request to treat subsequent chance as first chance. This data in portal can be treated as reference data for University to make students eligible for Honours.
- (ii) To verify the following documents by the Institution and through the portal for final verification by the University.
 - Document to prove a student was outside the state at the time of his/her exam time.
 - If a student produces Covid Positive Certificate, check whether certificate date is close to exam dates in which student was absent.
 - Document to prove a student suffered Covid related infection. If IP bills of hospital are produced, check the dates with student's exam date in which (s)he was absent.
 - Document to prove a student was in quarantine when (s)he was absent in an examination.
- (iii) To provide a Certificate stating that, this supplementary chance shall be considered as their first chance on request and the Syndicate shall decide whether to collect fee of Rs.300/- i.e. fee for other miscellaneous Certificates fee.


First Chance Certificate

Adding a request for first chance certificate (Student)


Exam -> First Chance Certificate Request




1. The student will have to go to exam module and click on first chance certificate request menu

2. Clicking on the menu this will take the student to the list of the supplementary exams that he/she has passed and was initially absent for the regular mode of examination to which he/she can add a request for first chance certificate by clicking on **add request** button as shown below.






- 3. After clicking on the **add request** button the user will be taken to a page where the **Basic details**, **Contact details**, **Course details** of the student will be shown.
 - Under Basic Details the name, register number, branch is shown
 - Under **Contact details** the mobile number and email of the student will be shown The student is able to change the mobile number and email details if needed.






4. Under the **Course details** there will be a list of all the courses that the student has passed and is eligible for the first chance certificate, the student must click on the checkbox under the action column to select the required courses for first chance certificate.

Note * The amount shown under the course details in the picture above is for **testing** purposes only the actual amount may vary as per the university's decision.




5. The student must add atleast one attachment and after confirming the details the student can save the request as shown below





6. After saving the request the student can submit the request which will take the student to the viewing page of the request that he/she submitted.



7. After submitting the details the student can view the details along with the current status and previous status of the request and then the student can proceed to the payment, Where the student can choose the desired payment gateway and place the payment for the certificate.
